



### RACK CLEARANCE STANDARD PIVOT

From a line drawn vertically from the centerline of your security pin, the rack will intrude 1" past this line with the 12" pivot. This is fine for most vehicles, except vehicles with spare tires on the rear door, or where the back of the vehicle is a tall vertical face, such as a cargo van.

For vehicles with spare tires or for the back of vans, the 18" pivot will provide 3" of clearance between the upper wheel cradles and a line drawn vertically from the face of the hitch receiver.

Removing the lock pin allows the rack to recline about 35° against the stop pin.

Removing the stop pin allows the rack to recline all the way to the ground.
